Trainer of Trainers session in Brașov, Romania*

Between the 29th of July and the 6th of August will take place in Brașov, Romania the project „**Trainer's Laboratory – Experience non-formal training tools!**”, founded by European Commission, through „Youth in Action” Programme.

„**Trainer's Laboratory – Experience non-formal training tools!**” is a Training of Trainers focused on teaching the participants how to create their own non-formal education tools/methods and giving them the space to experiment within the group and receive feedback for the tools they will develop.

For 8 days, 23 participants (trainers, future trainers, youth workers - especially in the field of education) from Austria, Bulgaria, Denmark, Italy, Portugal, Romania and Turkey will have the chance to gain knowledge about non-formal education and find new ways to use it in their future trainings.

The project is supported by the European Commission through „Youth in Action” (YiA) Programme that provides the legal framework to support non-formal learning activities for young people. The YiA objectives include promoting active citizenship among young people, developing tolerance and solidarity, support youth activities and capacities of youth organizations and to promote European cooperation between youths.
